In-Person Sessions:



Lit. Center (K-5): Join our Literacy Center team to discover ways to enhance your child's literacy skills at home. The session will involve engaging hands-on activities.

College and Career Readiness (Grades 6-12): Understand the significance of 504 plans in your child's college and career readiness.
